18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 129 of Title 20, unless there is  
21 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A district judge, municipal judge, or retired district judge who  
23 receives a statement from the appropriate retirement system  
24 verifying the status of the person as a retired district judge, may

1 carry a firearm on his or her person anywhere in the state to use  
2 only for personal protection if the person has successfully  
3 completed an approved course of firearm training conducted by a  
4 state-certified firearms instructor which meets the minimum  
5 requirements for firearms training as set forth by the Council on  
6 Law Enforcement Education and Training.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013."

13 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 129 of Title 20, unless there is

16 A district judge, or retired district judge who receives a  
17 statement from the appropriate retirement system verifying the  
18 status of the person as a retired district judge, may carry a  
19 firearm on his or her person anywhere in the state to use only for  
20 personal protection if the person has successfully completed an  
21 approved course of firearm training conducted by a state-certified  
22 firearms instructor which meets the minimum requirements for  
23 firearms training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement  
24 Education and Training.
