8 An Act relating to statutes and reports; amending 75
9 O.S. 2011, Section 14, which relates to the
10 distribution of statutes and session laws; modifying
11 procedure and responsibility for purchase of
12 statutes, cumulative supplements to the statutes, and
13 session laws; allowing purchase in printed or digital
14 form; providing that certain libraries and the
15 Oklahoma Department of Libraries shall receive copies
16 at no cost; providing for purchase by the Chief Clerk
17 of the House of Representatives; providing for
18 procedure for placement of orders; requiring
19 submission of copy of order to the Chief Clerk of the
20 House of Representatives within a certain time;
21 repealing 75 O.S. 2011, Sections 13 and 17, which
22 relate to distribution and requisition of statutes;
23 and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 75 O.S. 2011, Section 14, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 14. A. The following officers shall be entitled to
~~receive as soon as available from the state without cost~~ purchase
copies in printed or digital form of the ~~printed~~ volumes of the
statutes and session laws of the state ~~published or purchased by the~~

1 ~~Legislature, or under its authority, for distribution~~ from the
2 publisher at the prices provided for in the agreement authorized by
3 Section 191 of this title:

4 1. Each state officer, including the Governor and Lieutenant
5 Governor, the chief administrative officers ~~and assistants~~ of state
6 departments, boards, and commissions, ~~upon written application and~~
7 ~~request submitted to the Chief Clerk-Administrator of the Oklahoma~~
8 ~~House of Representatives, within sixty (60) days of January 1 of~~
9 ~~each year, and said volumes shall be distributed at the discretion~~
10 ~~of the Chief Clerk-Administrator of the Oklahoma House of~~
11 Representatives; provided, the purchases shall be pursuant to a
12 contract between the publisher and the Purchasing Division of the
13 Office of Management and Enterprise Services and pursuant to The
14 Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; and

15 2. ~~Each member~~ The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives
16 and the Secretary of the Senate for the members and staff of the
17 Legislature; and

18 3. The Justices of the Supreme Court and the Judges of the
19 Court of Criminal Appeals, and the clerk of said Courts; ~~and~~

20 4. The chief administrative officers of the state educational,
21 benevolent, and penal institutions; provided, the purchases, except
22 for purchases by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and
23 the institutions, centers or other constituent agencies of The
24 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, shall be pursuant to a

1 contract between the publisher and the Purchasing Division of the
2 Office of Management and Enterprise Services and pursuant to The
3 Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; and

4 5. The judges of the district courts and district court clerks;
5 ~~and~~

6 6. County clerks; ~~and~~

7 7. County treasurers; ~~and~~

8 8. County assessors; ~~and~~

9 9. District attorneys and one assistant district attorney in
10 each county; provided, the purchases shall be pursuant to a contract
11 between the publisher and the Purchasing Division of the Office of
12 Management and Enterprise Services and pursuant to The Oklahoma
13 Central Purchasing Act; and

14 10. Sheriffs; and

15 11. ~~All members~~ Members of the Oklahoma Congressional
16 Delegation; ~~and.~~

17 B. The following shall be entitled to receive from the state
18 without cost copies of the statutes and session laws to be purchased
19 by the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives:

20 ~~12.~~ 1. Each library association organized in any county, city,
21 or town in this state for the benefit of the public.

22 ~~B. Fifty-five (55) copies of the statutes and session laws~~
23 ~~shall be furnished to the;~~

1 2. The law library of the College of Law of the University of
2 Oklahoma, ~~five copies to be kept for use therein and fifty copies~~
3 ~~for purposes of exchange.~~

4 ~~C. Five (5) copies of the statutes and session laws shall be~~
5 ~~placed in the;~~

6 3. The library of Oklahoma State University at Stillwater,
7 Oklahoma, for use therein.

8 ~~D. One hundred ten (110) copies of the statutes and session~~
9 ~~laws shall be furnished to the; and~~

10 4. The Oklahoma Department of Libraries for its use and
11 exchange purposes.

12 ~~E. The Chief Clerk-Administrator may, in his discretion,~~
13 ~~furnish from any copies of such laws on hand to state officers other~~
14 ~~than those specified in this section for the use of their offices.~~

15 C. Each person or entity provided for in subsection A of this
16 section that intends to purchase digital access or printed copies of
17 the statutes, cumulative supplements to the statutes, or session
18 laws from the publisher shall place the order directly with the
19 publisher and shall furnish a copy of the order to the Chief Clerk
20 of the House of Representatives within thirty (30) days after the
21 order is placed with the publisher.

22 SECTION 2. REPEALER 75 O.S. 2011, Sections 13 and 17,
23 are hereby repealed.

24 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
