18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.23, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 150.23 A. An officer, investigator, or agent of the
22 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the Oklahoma State Bureau of
23 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Department of Wildlife
24 Conservation, the Law Enforcement Division of the Oklahoma Horse

1 Racing Commission, the State Fire Marshal's Office, the Oklahoma
2 Tourism and Recreation Department, the Office of Inspector General
3 and the Oklahoma Child Support Services divisions of the Department
4 of Human Services or the office of a district attorney shall be
5 entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of length of service,
6 the continued custody and possession of the sidearm and badge
7 carried by such officer, investigator, or agent immediately prior to
8 retirement.

9 B. An officer, investigator, or agent specified in subsection A
10 of this section may be entitled to receive, upon retirement by
11 reason of disability, the continued custody and possession of the
12 sidearm and badge carried by such officer or agent immediately prior
13 to retirement upon written approval of the applicable Director of
14 the appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or district
15 attorney.

16 C. Custody and possession of the sidearm and badge of an
17 officer, investigator, or agent who dies while employed by any
18 Bureau, Department, Commission, or office specified in subsection A
19 of this section may be awarded by the applicable Director of the
20 appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or office to the spouse
21 or next of kin of the deceased officer, investigator, or agent.

22 D. A correctional officer, a probation and parole officer or an
23 internal affairs agent of the Oklahoma Department of Corrections
24 shall be entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of length of

1 service, the continued custody and possession of the badge carried
2 by such officer immediately prior to retirement.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.23, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 150.23 A. An officer, investigator, or agent of the
17 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the Oklahoma State Bureau of
18 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Department of Wildlife
19 Conservation, the Law Enforcement Division of the Oklahoma Horse
20 Racing Commission, the State Fire Marshal's Office, the Oklahoma
21 Tourism and Recreation Department, the Office of Inspector General
22 and the Oklahoma Child Support Services divisions of the Department
23 of Human Services or the office of a district attorney shall be
24 entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of length of service,

1 the continued custody and possession of the sidearm and badge
2 carried by such officer, investigator, or agent immediately prior to
3 retirement.

4 B. An officer, investigator, or agent specified in subsection A
5 of this section may be entitled to receive, upon retirement by
6 reason of disability, the continued custody and possession of the
7 sidearm and badge carried by such officer or agent immediately prior
8 to retirement upon written approval of the applicable Director of
9 the appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or district
10 attorney.

11 C. Custody and possession of the sidearm and badge of an
12 officer, investigator, or agent who dies while employed by any
13 Bureau, Department, Commission, or office specified in subsection A
14 of this section may be awarded by the applicable Director of the
15 appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or office to the spouse
16 or next of kin of the deceased officer, investigator, or agent.

17 D. A correctional officer of the Oklahoma Department of
18 Corrections shall be entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason
19 of length of service, the continued custody and possession of the
20 badge carried by such officer immediately prior to retirement.

21 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
