13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.194 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The section of Interstate 44 beginning at mile marker 42 and
18 extending north to mile marker 44 within Comanche County shall be
19 designated as the "LCpl Lamont N. Wilson Memorial Highway". The
20 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
21 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.195 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 74 beginning at the intersection of
2 West Waterloo Road and extending north to the intersection of State
3 Highway 74F shall be designated as the "Lance Corporal Jonathan
4 Stroud Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
5 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
6 the highway.

7 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.196 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the municipal limits
11 of Perry and extending east to the municipal limits of Morrison
12 shall be designated as the "Captain Kyle King Memorial Highway".
13 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
14 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

15 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.197 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The bridge over the Washita River on State Highway 53 northeast
19 of the municipal limits of Ardmore shall be designated as the "PFC
20 Philip F. Gaines Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
21 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
22 placed on the bridge.

1 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.198 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over Lake Eufaula on State Highway 9A between the
5 municipal limits of Canadian and Longtown shall be designated as the
6 "First Lieutenant S.W. "Dub" George Memorial Bridge". The
7 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
8 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

9 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.199 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The section of State Highway 7 beginning at the intersection of
13 State Highway 65 in Comanche County and extending eastward to the
14 intersection of U.S. Highway 81 in Stephens County shall be
15 designated as the "Army Ranger Staff Sgt. Vinson Bryon "Trinity"
16 Adkinson, III Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
17 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
18 placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 7. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 4022, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 4022. The Department of Transportation shall contract
22 with a person, firm, group or association in the State of Oklahoma
23 to establish a logo signing program for the purpose of providing on
24 the right-of-way and controlled access highways specific information

1 on gas, food, camping, tourism attractions ~~and~~, lodging, technology
2 center school districts, and higher education institutions for the
3 benefit of the motoring public.

4 SECTION 8. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 4023, is
5 amended to read as follows:

6 Section 4023. The Department of Transportation shall contract
7 to erect and maintain, on the right-of-way of interstate and
8 controlled access highways, logo signs informing the public of gas,
9 food, lodging ~~and~~, camping, technology center school district, and
10 higher education institution facilities. The contractor shall
11 furnish, install, maintain, and replace signs for the benefit of
12 advertisers who provide gas, food, camping and lodging facilities
13 for the general public, and lease advertising space on the sign to
14 operators of these facilities.

15 SECTION 9. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014."
