14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill
and insert
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16 "An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Regents for
Higher Education; requiring the State Regents for
17 Higher Education to annually submit a report to the
Legislature; establishing the contents of the
18 report; providing for codification; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3218.16 of Title 70, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall provide
2 information concerning all baccalaureate programs offered by
3 institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education.
4 The information shall contain the following regarding each
5 baccalaureate program for the preceding five (5) years:

6 1. The average five-year graduation rate for first-time college
7 enrollees who are full-time bachelor-degree-seeking students;

8 2. The average amount of debt accrued by students who incurred
9 student loan debt to complete their studies;

10 3. The percentage of students employed within the field of
11 study of their degree upon graduation from an institution;

12 4. The average starting salary of graduates from the
13 institution who are employed in the field of study of their degree;
14 and

15 5. Make information available to students and their parents or
16 any other financially responsible party reporting the projected
17 level of debt incurred by students enrolled in the institution who,
18 in obtaining their degree, incurred debt and information presented
19 detailing the academic programs which are in high demand in the
20 Oklahoma economy.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

14 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3218.16 of Title 70, unless

17 The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall annually
18 submit a report to the Legislature providing information concerning
19 all baccalaureate programs offered in the Oklahoma State System of
20 Higher Education. The report shall contain the following
21 information regarding each baccalaureate offering for the preceding
22 five (5) years:

23 1. The average five-year graduation rate for first-time college
24 enrollees;

1 2. The average debt incurred by students who incurred student
2 loan debt to complete their studies;

3 3. The percentage of students employed within the discipline of
4 their studies upon graduation; and

5 4. Information presented at the conclusion of the sophomore
6 year of study to students and their parents or financially
7 responsible party reporting the projected level of debt incurred by
8 those students who, in obtaining their degree, incurred debt, and
9 information detailing other academic programs which are in high
10 demand in the Oklahoma economy.

11 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

12 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
