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20 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

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22 "An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2011,
23 Section 1210.199, which relates to the Dustin Rhodes
and Lindsay Steed CPR Training Act; requiring that
24 certain students receive instruction in
cardiopulmonary resuscitation and certain awareness
between certain grade levels; providing for waivers

1 and exceptions; allowing certain students to receive
2 instruction in the Heimlich maneuver between certain
3 grades; directing the State Board of Education to
4 establish a monitoring procedure; requiring the use
5 of psychomotor skills in certain program; directing
6 that program shall be based upon certain
7 instructional programs; providing definition;
8 permitting use of certain personnel; allowing certain
9 agreements; requiring certain instructor for
10 certification instruction; and providing an effective
11 date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.199, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1210.199 A. This act shall be known and may be cited
16 as the "Dustin Rhodes and Lindsay Steed CPR Training Act".

17 B. ~~All~~ Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, all students
18 ~~enrolled in physical education in classes in grades nine through~~
19 ~~twelve in the public schools of this state may receive instruction~~
20 ~~in the techniques of~~ shall receive instruction in cardiopulmonary
21 ~~resuscitation and the Heimlich maneuver sufficient to enable the~~
22 ~~students to give emergency assistance to victims of cardiac arrest~~
23 ~~or choking~~ awareness of the purpose of an automated external
24 defibrillator, in accordance with subsection C of this section, at
least once between ninth grade and graduation from high school. The
instruction may be provided as a part of any course. A school
administrator may waive the curriculum requirement required by this
subsection for an eligible student who has a disability. A student

1 shall not be required to meet the requirement of this subsection if
2 a parent or guardian of the student objects in writing. All
3 students enrolled in a virtual charter school in grades nine through
4 twelve shall not be subject to the requirements of this section.
5 All students enrolled in physical education classes in grades nine
6 through twelve may receive instruction in the techniques of the
7 Heimlich maneuver.

8 C. ~~The State Department of Education may administer the~~
9 ~~cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the Heimlich maneuver instruction~~
10 ~~program and train teaching personnel pursuant to rules adopted by~~
11 ~~the State Board of Education. Teaching materials and training~~
12 ~~courses provided by the American Red Cross, the American Heart~~
13 ~~Association and similar organizations may be utilized~~ The State
14 Board of Education shall establish a procedure for monitoring the
15 requirements set forth in subsection B of this section. Instruction
16 in cardiopulmonary resuscitation shall incorporate psychomotor
17 skills training and shall be based upon an instructional program
18 which is nationally recognized and is based upon the most current
19 national evidence-based Emergency Cardiovascular Care guidelines for
20 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external
21 defibrillator.

22 D. Each public school district board of education shall ensure
23 that a minimum of one certified teacher and one noncertified staff
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1 member at each school site receives training in cardiopulmonary
2 resuscitation and the Heimlich maneuver each year.

3 E. School districts may use state funds allocated to the school
4 district for professional development to pay for or to reimburse
5 teachers and support personnel for training in the administration of
6 first aid and techniques of cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the
7 Heimlich maneuver.

8 F. Nothing in this section shall be construed to impose
9 liability on any school district or school district employee for
10 injury or death of any student, teacher, or other person resulting
11 from any cardiopulmonary or choking incident or to absolve any
12 school district or school employee of liability that might otherwise
13 exist under The Governmental Tort Claims Act.

14 G. For purposes of this section, "psychomotor skills" means the
15 use of hands-on practice to support cognitive learning.

16 H. A school district may use emergency medical technicians,
17 paramedics, police officers, firefighters, teachers, other school
18 employees or other similarly qualified individuals or organizations
19 to provide the instruction prescribed by this section. Two or more
20 school districts may enter into an interlocal or multi-district
21 cooperative agreement for the purpose of jointly and comparatively
22 fulfilling the requirements of this section. Instruction provided
23 pursuant to this section is not required to result in certification
24 in cardiopulmonary resuscitation. If instruction is intended to

1 result in certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation, the course
2 instructor shall be authorized by an instructional program which is
3 nationally recognized and is based upon the most current national
4 evidence-based Emergency Cardiovascular Care guidelines for
5 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external
6 defibrillator or a similar nationally recognized association to
7 provide the instruction.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014."
