10 Anti-Hunger Act; *** good-faith donations of food;
11 requiring donor to provide certain information
12 concerning food; requiring segregation of certain
13 food; requiring posting of certain notice; providing
14 for codification; and declaring an emergency.

15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and
16 entire bill and insert

17 "[poor persons - Josephine Meade Anti-Hunger Act -
18 codification -
19 emergency]

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.2 of Title 56, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 This section and Section 2 of this act shall be known and may be
2 cited as the "Josephine Meade Anti-Hunger Act".

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.3 of Title 56, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The Department of Human Services shall allow the patrons of
7 senior nutrition project sites to take home leftover food. The
8 Department may seek ways to receive donated packaged or
9 nonperishable food, as well as natural fresh foods such as fruits
10 and vegetables, for distribution to patrons, with no requirements
11 for project sites to provide overnight storage. The Department
12 shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.

13 The State Department of Education shall develop policies to
14 prevent food waste in public school cafeterias and for
15 redistributing leftover foods to students in need. The Department
16 may seek ways to receive donated packaged or nonperishable food, as
17 well as natural fresh foods such as fruits and vegetables, for
18 distribution to needy students, with no requirements for school
19 cafeterias to provide overnight storage. The State Board of
20 Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this
21 act.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
