√ Changes made in conference:

Section 1: Directs school districts' amended policies regarding Epinephrine injectors to require rather than allow parent notification, require a waiver of liability from a parent to be on file prior to administration of injectors, and the designation of an employee responsible for obtaining the injectors. A school employee must call 911 as soon as possible if a student is believed to be having an anaphylactic reaction. The State Board of Education must develop a model policy.
