General Subject Matter: Revenue and Taxation

General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

Section 1. Reduces, from three to two, the number of opportunities that a taxpayer can reschedule an informal hearing with the assessor. The assessor must provide two alternative dates on different days of the week, where the taxpayer can participate in the informal hearing, either in person or telephonically, with the assessor or an authorized representative of the assessor.

Section 2: Requires the county board of equalization in any county with a population of less than 300,000 to provide at least three dates where the taxpayer may personally appear to make a presentation of evidence. Previously, engrossed 3119 required all counties to adhere the 3 opportunity requirement regardless of population.
