9 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
10 2011, Section 11-1110, which relates to wrecker  
11 cleanup services; requiring certain insurance  
12 policies to include certain coverage; and providing  
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-1110, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 11-1110. A. No person shall throw or deposit upon any  
18 highway any glass bottle, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans or any  
19 other substances likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle upon  
20 such highway.

21 B. Any person who drops, or permits to be dropped or thrown,  
22 upon any highway any destructive or injurious material shall  
23 immediately remove the same or cause it to be removed.

1 C. Any person removing a wrecked or damaged vehicle from a  
2 highway, highway right-of-way or any other location as the result of  
3 an accident shall remove any glass or other injurious substance  
4 dropped upon the highway or highway right-of-way or other location  
5 from such vehicle. The owner or insurer of the owner of the vehicle  
6 ~~if the owner's insurance policy provides coverage for such expense,~~  
7 shall be responsible for the cost of removal of the vehicle and the  
8 glass or other injurious substance and any vehicle storage fees. No  
9 insurance policy insuring against loss resulting from liability  
10 imposed by law shall be issued in this state unless the policy  
11 includes coverage for this cost. The cost of the removal of the  
12 vehicle and any storage fees shall be the same as established by the  
13 Corporation Commission for nonconsensual tows.

14 D. No person shall throw any substance at a standing vehicle or  
15 any occupant thereof, nor shall any person throw any substance at a  
16 person on or adjacent to a highway.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
