8 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care
10 Authority; authorizing and directing the Authority to
11 submit certain waiver; authorizing actions; providing
12 for effect of provisions with respect to federal or
13 other law applicable to federally recognized Native
14 American tribes; providing that act may be null and
15 void under certain circumstance; providing for
16 codification; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028 of Title 63, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall be authorized and
22 directed to submit a waiver to the Center for Medicaid and Medicare
23 Services. The waiver will be for uncompensated care provided in
24 Indian Health Service health facilities, Native American tribal
health facilities and Urban Indian Organization health facilities.
The waiver will provide payments to these facilities for formerly

1 reimbursable services, and more generally to cover otherwise
2 uncompensated care.

3 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority may take such actions,
4 including but not limited to any waivers authorized by federal law,
5 in order to perform obligations pursuant to agreements entered into
6 pursuant to subsection A of this section.

7 C. To the extent required by the provisions of federal law,
8 tribal law or other provisions of law affecting a federally
9 recognized Native American tribe, the provisions of this section and
10 the actions taken by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority authorized
11 by this section shall be deemed and shall constitute the consent of
12 the State of Oklahoma to agreements executed by the Oklahoma Health
13 Care Authority.

14 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5029 of Title 63, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 If the Oklahoma Health Care Authority is unable to obtain
18 federal financial participation and waiver approval from the Center
19 for Medicaid and Medicare Services, this act shall be null and void.

20 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
