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8 PROPOSED SUBCOMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care
10 Authority; authorizing certain agreements with
11 federally recognized Native American tribes or
12 tribally owned business entities; authorizing
13 actions; providing for effect of provisions with
14 respect to federal or other law applicable to
15 federally recognized Native American tribes;
16 providing for codification; and declaring an
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028 of Title 63, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall be authorized to
23 enter into agreements with one or more federally recognized Native
24 American tribes, or with any business entity organized pursuant to
the laws of the State of Oklahoma if the business entity is
controlled by a federally recognized Native American tribe and

1 conducts business in furtherance of an authorized function of a
2 tribe, to provide health care services to underserved persons, low
3 income persons, disabled persons, senior citizens, expectant mothers
4 or other persons that seek and receive medical attention or
5 treatment through a federally recognized Native American tribe or a
6 tribally controlled business entity.

7 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority may take such actions,
8 including but not limited to any waivers authorized by federal law,
9 in order to perform obligations pursuant to agreements entered into
10 pursuant to subsection A of this section.

11 C. To the extent required by the provisions of federal law,
12 tribal law or other provisions of law affecting a federally
13 recognized Native American tribe, the provisions of this section and
14 the actions taken by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority authorized
15 by this section shall be deemed and shall constitute the consent of
16 the State of Oklahoma to agreements executed by the Oklahoma Health
17 Care Authority.

18 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
