8 An Act relating to militia; amending 44 O.S. 2011,
9 Section 21.1, which relates to Military Department
10 personnel; providing certain employees to be in the
11 classified service; authorizing the Adjutant General
12 to establish certain requirements; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 21.1, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 21.1. Personnel appointed as state employees in the
18 Military Department shall be in the ~~unclassified~~ classified service
19 of the state, except as otherwise provided by law, and shall be
20 subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Personnel Act concerning
21 appointments, promotions, adverse actions, and all other personnel
22 matters. However, the Adjutant General may establish a requirement
23 for membership in the National Guard as a special requirement for
24 appointment to, and continued employment in, certain positions in

1 the classified service which require special military training,
2 exercise of command authority, direct specified military programs,
3 or require the performance of other functions directly related to
4 administration and training of the National Guard or the maintenance
5 or repair of National Guard facilities, equipment, or supplies.
6 Such designated positions shall include the specified military grade
7 or grades authorized by the Adjutant General for appointment to the
8 position and continued employment therein. An employee in a
9 designated position who is separated from the National Guard or who
10 does not hold the specified military grade for the position will be
11 reclassified, promoted, demoted, transferred or separated in
12 accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Personnel Act and the
13 Merit Rules for Employment. The Adjutant General may grant leave to
14 state civilian employees consistent with the rules governing the
15 federal workforce in support of the National Guard.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
