9 An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; requiring
10 low-point beer wholesalers provide proof of alcohol
11 content; providing penalty; providing for
12 promulgation of rules; providing for codification;
13 and providing an effective date.

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.12.1 of Title 37, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Every wholesaler prior to being issued a permit or renewing
20 a permit pursuant to Section 163.7 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma
21 Statutes to sell low-point beer in this state shall by affidavit
22 provide test results to the Oklahoma Tax Commission for each style
23 of each brand sold by the wholesaler establishing that the beer does
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1 not contain more than three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) of alcohol
2 by weight.

3 B. Any person who knowingly makes any false affidavit pursuant
4 to this section is guilty of perjury and upon conviction shall be
5 punished pursuant to the provisions of Section 500 of Title 21 of
6 the Oklahoma Statutes.

7 C. The Tax Commission shall promulgate rules establishing
8 necessary procedures and administering the provisions of this
9 section.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
