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9 An Act relating to schools; creating the Education
10 for Responsible Citizenship Act; permitting each
11 technology center school district to provide certain
12 programs to certain individuals; providing for
13 certain components to be included in programs;
14 requiring revenue to be reported each school year;
15 requiring the promulgation of rules; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-130 of Title 70, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Education for
22 Responsible Citizenship Act".

23 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-131 of Title 70, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. The State Board of Career and Technology Education may
2 require each technology center school district, upon the approval of
3 the local technology center board of education, to provide Education
4 for Responsible Citizenship Programs to eligible youth who are
5 referred by the juvenile courts, the Office of Juvenile Affairs or
6 juvenile bureaus. Youth need not be adjudicated to be eligible.
7 Education for Responsible Citizenship Programs shall be offered in
8 addition to any existing alternative education programs offered by
9 technology center school districts.

10 B. The State Board of Career and Technology Education shall
11 require that the following components are included in the Education
12 for Responsible Citizenship Programs:

- 13 1. Education assessment;
- 14 2. Academic instruction coordinated with local public school
15 districts;
- 16 3. Current occupational skill training instruction;
- 17 4. Community service learning coordinated with local youth
18 services organizations and local public school districts;
- 19 5. Job counseling placement referrals related to occupational
20 training;
- 21 6. Parent involvement;
- 22 7. Career development; and
- 23 8. Technology exploration.

1 C. All revenue received and expended for students participating
2 in the Education for Responsible Citizenship Programs shall be
3 reported to the State Board of Career and Technology Education each
4 school year.

5 D. The State Board of Career and Technology Education, after
6 consultation with designees of the Oklahoma Supreme Court, the
7 Office of Juvenile Affairs and the juvenile bureaus, shall
8 promulgate rules as necessary to administer the Education for
9 Responsible Citizenship Programs and the process by which the
10 funding shall be allocated.

11 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
