13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2514.1 of Title 63, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Other than for gross negligence, no ambulance authority or its
18 individual employees shall be liable as an entity or individually
19 for any civil damages as the result of an act or the omission of an
20 act committed while in training for or in the rendering of life
21 support services in accordance with the Oklahoma Emergency Response
22 Systems Development Act.
