8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care  
9 Authority; directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority  
10 to conduct bidding process to select a provider to  
11 perform an audit; requiring audit to include certain  
12 factors; providing for noncodification; and providing  
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is directed to conduct a  
18 bidding process in which a third party provider shall be selected to  
19 perform an audit on the Authority.

20 B. The audit shall include:

- 21 1. Administrative costs and overhead;  
22 2. Health outcomes;  
23 3. Eligibility criteria for dual eligibility populations as  
24 compared to other states; and

1           4.   Audit and performance review of total narcotic usage.

2   SECTION 2.   This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
