11 An Act relating to the University Hospitals
12 Authority; providing for duties and compensation of
13 employees; requiring compliance with and providing
14 budgetary limitations; requiring and prohibiting
15 certain budget procedures; requiring transfers of
16 certain funds; requiring certain funds be used for
17 certain programs; providing lapse dates; providing an
18 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not
21 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
22 upon the University Hospitals Authority by law shall be set by the
23 University Hospitals Authority.

24 SECTION 2. TRANSFER The University Hospitals Authority
shall transfer the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
(\$500,000.00) from the funds appropriated in Section 68 of Enrolled

1 House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma
2 Legislature to the University Hospitals Authority Disbursing Fund
3 created by Section 3221 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to be
4 expended in accordance with law.

5 SECTION 3. TRANSFER The University Hospitals Authority
6 shall transfer the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) from
7 the funds appropriated in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301
8 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature to the Oklahoma
9 Institute for Disaster and Emergency Medicine Revolving Fund
10 established pursuant to Section 1-2523 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma
11 Statutes, to be expended in accordance with law.

12 SECTION 4. TRANSFER The University Hospitals Authority
13 shall transfer the sum of Six Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars
14 (\$625,000.00) from the funds appropriated in Section 68 of Enrolled
15 House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma
16 Legislature to the Dental Loan Repayment Revolving Fund established
17 pursuant to Section 1-2714 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to
18 be expended in accordance with law.

19 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the University
20 Hospitals Authority in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of
21 the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Three Million
22 Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) shall be used for patient care at the
23 University of Oklahoma Wayman Tisdale Specialty Health Clinic.

1 SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the University
2 Hospitals Authority in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of
3 the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Seven Hundred
4 Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$712,000.00) shall be used for providing
5 hearing services for deaf and/or hard of hearing children statewide.

6 SECTION 7. From the funds appropriated to the University
7 Hospitals Authority in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of
8 the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Two Hundred
9 Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be used for the purpose of
10 enhancing the quality of Oklahoma primary care practices through
11 Area Health Education Centers and Public Health Institute of
12 Oklahoma programs.

13 SECTION 8. From the funds appropriated to the University
14 Hospitals Authority in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of
15 the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, One Hundred
16 Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be expended for contractual
17 outreach dental services in the State of Oklahoma provided by the
18 Oklahoma Dental Association.

19 SECTION 9. Appropriations made by Section 68 of Enrolled House
20 Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature,
21 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may
22 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 (hereafter FY-
23 14) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015
24 (hereafter FY-15). Funds budgeted for FY-14 may be encumbered only

1 through June 30, 2014, and must be expended by November 15, 2014.
2 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2014, and not budgeted for
3 FY-15, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
4 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered
5 only through June 30, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15,
6 2015, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
7 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in
8 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-14, and not
9 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
10 for FY-15, after the agency to which the funds have been
11 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
12 revision removing these funds from the FY-14 budget work program and
13 after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management
14 and Enterprise Services.

15 SECTION 10. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

16 SECTION 11. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
