9 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
10 2011, Section 11-403.1, which relates to penalties  
11 for failing to yield; modifying fee amount;  
12 clarifying purpose of fee; providing for the deposit  
13 of fees; defining term; and providing an effective  
14 date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-403.1, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 11-403.1 A. Any person convicted of failure to yield a  
19 right-of-way and who causes a fatality or serious bodily injury as a  
20 result of such violation may, in addition to any other fine or  
21 penalty, be assessed a fee ~~in an amount not exceeding~~ of One  
22 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) ~~to~~.

23 B. Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) of the fee provided for in  
24 subsection A of this section shall be deposited in the Motorcycle  
Safety and Education Program Revolving Fund established in Section

1 40-123 of this title. The monies deposited as provided in this  
2 ~~section~~ subsection shall be used to promote public awareness of the  
3 dangers of driving while under the influence of alcohol or any  
4 controlled substance ~~and,~~ to promote motorcycle safety and to  
5 promote public awareness of the importance of defensive driving for  
6 youth as it relates to motorcycle traffic.

7 C. Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) of the fee provided for in  
8 subsection A of this section shall be forwarded to the office of the  
9 district attorney of the county where the conviction was obtained.

10 D. For purposes of this section, "convicted" means any final  
11 adjudication of guilty, whether pursuant to a plea of guilty or nolo  
12 contendere or otherwise, and any deferred judgment or suspended  
13 sentence.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
