9 An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S.  
10 2011, Section 4-138, which relates to wildlife  
11 conservation passports; authorizing the Wildlife  
12 Conservation Commission to establish certain  
13 passport; authorizing the Commission to assess  
14 certain fee; modifying exemption; authorizing  
15 purchase of certain substitute license under certain  
16 circumstances; directing certain fees be deposited  
17 into Wildlife Conservation Fund; and providing an  
18 effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2011, Section 4-138, is  
21 amended to read as follows:

22 Section 4-138. A. The Wildlife Conservation Commission may  
23 establish a special use ~~permit~~ permits to be designated the:

- 24 1. "Annual Wildlife Conservation Passport"; and
2. "Three-Day Wildlife Conservation Passport".

The A Passport shall be required of all persons not otherwise  
exempt as provided for in subsection C of this section, who enter or

1 use land owned by the Commission and that has been designated by the  
2 Commission as requiring a Passport.

3 B. The Commission may establish and assess ~~an annual~~:

4 1. A fee of not more than One Dollar (\$1.00) above the cost of  
5 an annual resident hunting or fishing license for the Annual  
6 Wildlife Conservation Passport; and

7 2. A fee of not more than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for the  
8 Three-Day Wildlife Conservation Passport.

9 Each person, not otherwise exempt as provided for in subsection  
10 C of this section, entering or using a designated area of land shall  
11 be required to have a Passport in their possession while in the  
12 area.

13 C. The following persons shall be exempt from the Passport  
14 requirements of this section:

15 1. All persons who possess a valid Oklahoma ~~annual~~ fishing,  
16 hunting or combination ~~resident fishing or hunting~~ license, ~~an~~  
17 ~~annual nonresident fishing or hunting license,~~ a lifetime resident  
18 or nonresident fishing, hunting, or combination license, a senior  
19 citizen lifetime fishing or hunting license, or a disability fishing  
20 or hunting license;

21 2. ~~Legal residents of Oklahoma who are~~ Persons under ~~eighteen~~  
22 ~~(18)~~ sixteen (16) years of age ~~on the first day of the current~~  
23 ~~calendar year;~~ and

1           3. Students and instructors participating in bona fide  
2 educational tours or activities sponsored or organized by an  
3 educational institution or entity or any other organized event  
4 sanctioned in advance by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife  
5 Conservation. Sponsors of such activities shall provide notice of  
6 the date and number of persons participating in the activity to the  
7 Department of Wildlife Conservation for approval not less than  
8 twenty (20) days prior to the date of the activity.

9           D. 1. Any person arrested while violating the provisions of  
10 this section may purchase a temporary thirty-day license from the  
11 arresting game warden in lieu of posting bond. The fee for a  
12 substitute license purchased pursuant to the provisions of this  
13 subsection shall be:

14                 a. Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for legal residents of this  
15                         state, and

16                 b. Ninety Dollars (\$90.00) for nonresidents.

17           2. The fees from licenses purchased pursuant to the provisions  
18 of this subsection shall be deposited in the Wildlife Conservation  
19 Fund to be used exclusively for developing, managing, preserving and  
20 protecting wildlife and wildlife habitat.

21           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
