10 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to memorial highway designations;
12 designating the LCpl Lamont N. Wilson Memorial
13 Highway; designating the Lance Corporal Jonathan
14 Stroud Memorial Highway; designating the Captain Kyle
15 King Memorial Highway; designating the PFC Philip F.
16 Gaines Memorial Bridge; designating the First
17 Lieutenant S.W. "Dub" George Memorial Bridge;
18 requiring certain markers; providing for
19 codification; and providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.194 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 The section of Interstate 44 beginning at mile marker 42 and
extending north to mile marker 44 within Comanche County shall be
designated as the "LCpl Lamont N. Wilson Memorial Highway". The

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
2 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.195 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of State Highway 74 beginning at the intersection of
7 West Waterloo Road and extending north to the intersection of State
8 Highway 74F shall be designated as the "Lance Corporal Jonathan
9 Stroud Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
10 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
11 the highway.

12 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.196 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the municipal limits
16 of Perry and extending east to the municipal limits of Morrison
17 shall be designated as the "Captain Kyle King Memorial Highway".
18 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
19 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

20 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.197 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge over the Washita River on State Highway 53 northeast
24 of the municipal limits of Ardmore shall be designated as the "PFC

1 Philip F. Gaines Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
2 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
3 placed on the bridge.

4 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.198 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge over Lake Eufaula on State Highway 9A between the
8 municipal limits of Canadian and Longtown shall be designated as the
9 "First Lieutenant S.W. "Dub" George Memorial Bridge". The
10 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
11 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

12 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
