10 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Regents for  
12 Higher Education; requiring the State Regents for  
13 Higher Education to annually submit a report to the  
14 Legislature; establishing the contents of the report;  
15 providing for codification; providing an effective  
16 date; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3218.16 of Title 70, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall annually  
22 submit a report to the Legislature providing information concerning  
23 all baccalaureate programs offered by institutions within The  
24 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. The report shall contain

1 the following information regarding each baccalaureate program for  
2 the preceding five (5) years:

3 1. The average five-year graduation rate for first-time college  
4 enrollees who are full-time bachelor-degree-seeking students;

5 2. The average amount of debt accrued by students who incurred  
6 student loan debt to complete their studies;

7 3. The percentage of students employed within the field of  
8 study of their degree upon graduation from an institution;

9 4. The average starting salary of graduates from the  
10 institution who are employed in the field of study of their degree;  
11 and

12 5. Information presented at the conclusion of the sophomore  
13 year of study to students and their parents or any other financially  
14 responsible party reporting the projected level of debt incurred by  
15 students enrolled in the institution who, in obtaining their degree,  
16 incurred debt and information presented detailing the academic  
17 programs which are in high demand in the Oklahoma economy.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
