8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Commission on  
9 Children and Youth; amending 10 O.S. 2011, Section  
10 601.3, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 15,  
11 O.S.L. 2013 (10 O.S. Supp. 2013, Section 601.3),  
which relates to duties of the Commission; permitting  
Commission to provide certain training; and providing  
an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2011, Section 601.3, as  
15 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 15, O.S.L. 2013 (10 O.S. Supp.  
16 2013, Section 601.3), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 601.3. The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth is  
18 hereby authorized and directed to:

19 1. Establish and maintain the Office of Planning and  
20 Coordination for Services to Children and Youth;

21 2. Establish and maintain the Office of Juvenile System  
22 Oversight;

23 3. Designate community partnership districts for services to  
24 children and youth and, within the limitations of available funds,

1 whether appropriated or otherwise available, provide staff,  
2 technical assistance and other assistance as necessary and  
3 appropriate to the district boards; ~~and~~

4 4. Establish services for the children of incarcerated parents.

5 Duties designed to improve the lives of children of incarcerated  
6 parents shall include:

7 a. coordinating research,

8 b. collecting data,

9 c. creating a resource clearinghouse,

10 d. developing an educational toolkit describing services  
11 available to children of incarcerated parents, and

12 e. coordinating an advisory committee to work  
13 collaboratively with agencies and service providers to  
14 better meet the needs and improve the quality of life  
15 for children of incarcerated parents; and

16 5. Conduct or otherwise provide continuing professional  
17 education and training for the purposes of improving services to  
18 children.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
