8 An Act relating to electromagnetic shield protection;
9 requiring electric providers to install certain
10 technology on critical infrastructure and facilities
11 by certain date; requiring the Southwest Power Pool
12 to identify critical equipment; requiring certain
13 design standards; authorizing recovery of certain
14 costs within certain time period; providing for
15 codification; providing ballot title; and directing
16 filing.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 3 of Article V of the Oklahoma
19 Constitution, there is hereby ordered the following legislative
20 referendum which shall be filed with the Secretary of State and
21 addressed to the Governor of the state, who shall submit the same to
22 the people for their approval or rejection at the next General
23 Election.

24 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 158 of Title 17, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

2 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

3 This measure requires electric transmission operators in this
4 state to install certain electromagnetic shield protection on
5 critical equipment by January 1, 2017. There shall be a rate
6 increase to recover costs of installing this equipment.

7 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?

10 SECTION 4. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
11 immediately after the passage of this order for legislative
12 referendum, prepare and file in accordance with Section 3 of Article
13 V of the Oklahoma Constitution, one copy of this order for
14 legislative referendum, including the Ballot Title set forth in
15 SECTION 3, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the
16 Attorney General.

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
