- 2) That the attached Conference Committee Substitute be adopted.





12 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

13 An Act relating to sole source purchase contracts;
14 authorizing substitution of certain products;
15 prohibiting purchasing restrictions to certain
16 geographical areas; authorizing promulgation of rules
17 to implement act; providing for codification;
18 providing for noncodification; and declaring an
19 emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.45j.1 of Title 74, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or agency rule to
2 the contrary, any bid submissions made by a state agency or any
3 political subdivision pursuant to authorized sole source bidding
4 procedures established by the provisions of Section 85.45j of Title
5 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, which substitute an item with one that
6 is alike in quality and design or which meets the required
7 specifications of the bid shall be considered. In terms of new
8 public construction contracts, at least three equivalent items from
9 more than one manufacturer and more than one supplier or
10 representative shall be included in the required specifications.

11 B. In addition, no sole source bid proposal shall require any
12 limitation that materials must be supplied from a vendor within any
13 specific geographical area. Geographic preference for vendors
14 inside the geographical boundaries may be given, but only when the
15 cost is the same or less.

16 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 The Office of Management and Enterprise Services is authorized
19 to promulgate rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this
20 act.

21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
23 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
24 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
