BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.42.1 of Title 62, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each agency subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma State
Finance Act shall develop a contingency plan and corresponding
budget to be prepared for up to a twenty-five percent (25%)

1 reduction in any applicable federal monies, whether appropriated or
2 received in block grant or any other form.

3 B. The contingency plan and corresponding budget shall be
4 submitted to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
5 Services, the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
6 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
7 Senate within thirty (30) days from the effective date of this act.

8 C. Every entity subject to the requirements of this section
9 shall make an annual disclosure pursuant to a separate written
10 report and information available through a website maintained by or
11 on behalf of the entity of all federal funds under the control of
12 the entity and the programs for which the federal funds are used by
13 distinct expenditure categories and shall identify the priority or
14 rank of the federal funds in descending order with the funding
15 source the agency relies on to the greatest extent listed first and
16 the funding source the agencies relies on to the least extent listed
17 last. The information required by this subsection shall include,
18 but shall not be limited to:

19 1. A description of any action required to be taken by the
20 state government entity as a condition for the receipt or continued
21 receipt of federal funds;

22 2. A description of any action prohibited to be taken by the
23 state government entity as a condition for the receipt or continued
24 receipt of federal funds;

1 3. A description of any action required to be taken by any
2 individual or lawfully recognized business entity or other entity as
3 a condition for the benefits purported to be conferred on the
4 individual or other legal entity as a result of the use of the
5 federal funds; and

6 4. A description of any action prohibited to be taken by any
7 individual or lawfully recognized business entity or other entity as
8 a condition for the benefits purported to be conferred on the
9 individual or other legal entity as a result of the use of the
10 federal funds.

11 D. Every entity subject to the requirements of this section
12 shall make an annual disclosure either pursuant to a separate
13 written report, information available through a website maintained
14 by or on behalf of the entity or both, of the federal funds for
15 which the agency must incur costs to implement and shall provide
16 such information in descending order with the most costly federal
17 funds listed first and the least costly federal funds listed last.

18 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
