

12 An Act relating to children; creating the Children
13 with Disabilities Comprehensive Systems of Services
14 Fund Act of 2013; creating the Children with
15 Disabilities Comprehensive Systems of Services
16 Revolving Fund; providing that fund consists of
17 monies deposited by certain foundation; establishing
18 foundation for certain purpose; requiring foundation
19 to secure tax-exempt status; requiring foundation
20 member to abstain from voting under certain
21 circumstance; providing for codification; and
22 providing an effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 601.66 of Title 10, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Children with
2 Disabilities Comprehensive Systems of Services Fund Act of 2013".

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 601.67 of Title 10, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
7 for the Board of Regents for the University of Oklahoma on behalf of
8 the Department of Pediatrics, Child Study Center for Sooner SUCCESS
9 to be designated the "Children with Disabilities Comprehensive
10 Systems of Services Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing
11 fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of
12 those monies appropriated to the fund by law or deposited in the
13 fund pursuant to Section 3 of this act. All monies accruing to the
14 credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
15 expended by Sooner SUCCESS for the purpose of coordinating a
16 statewide comprehensive system of health, social and educational
17 services for Oklahoma children and youth with special needs in
18 accordance with Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities
19 Education Act (IDEA) and Title V programs for Children with Special
20 Health Care Needs. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
21 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
22 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
23 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

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1 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 601.68 of Title 10, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. There is hereby authorized the establishment of a not-for-
5 profit foundation to raise funds for the Children with Disabilities
6 Comprehensive Systems of Services Fund Act of 2013 and the
7 achievement of the goals of the act.

8 B. The foundation created pursuant to this section may receive
9 funds from any public or private source to carry out the purposes of
10 this act, including, but not limited to, gifts or grants from any
11 department, agency, or instrumentality of the United States or of
12 this state for any purposes consistent with the provisions of this
13 act.

14 C. Upon proper incorporation, the foundation shall secure tax-
15 exempt status under the appropriate provision of Section 501(c) of
16 the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c).

17 D. Any member of the foundation who may have a financial
18 interest in an action under consideration by the foundation shall
19 abstain from voting on such matter.

20 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
