

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9 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to state employees; authorizing state  
11 agencies to offer voluntary payments for unused  
12 accrued annual leave to eligible employees; directing  
13 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
14 Services to appoint certain committee to study policy  
15 and develop rules; authorizing OMES to promulgate  
16 rules; providing for codification; and providing an  
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.20D of Title 74, unless  
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. State agencies are hereby authorized, at their discretion,  
23 up to two times annually, to offer their employees an option to  
24 voluntarily elect to be paid for a maximum of two hundred (200)  
hours of unused accrued annual leave. This policy will be optional  
for all eligible employees, and the agency may choose the monthly

1 pay period in which to provide such payment. The employee must  
2 retain one hundred twenty (120) hours of annual leave after the  
3 payment is made.

4 B. Upon the effective date of this act, the Director of the  
5 Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) shall appoint a  
6 committee, chaired by the Director or a designee, consisting of any  
7 number of employees representing any state agency the Director deems  
8 appropriate, to study and develop a policy and rules necessary to  
9 implement the program pursuant to subsection A of this section. The  
10 committee shall solicit input from state agencies and determine  
11 policies to establish employee eligibility and any other relevant  
12 requirements.

13 C. OMES is authorized and directed to promulgate administrative  
14 rules necessary to implement the provisions of this act.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
