8 An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
9 amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 633, which relates to  
10 the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act; allowing the  
11 State Board of Osteopathic Examiners to issue certain  
12 special licenses; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 633, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 633. Each applicant who has met all requirements for  
17 licensure shall be issued a license to practice as an osteopathic  
18 physician and surgeon. Upon application, the State Board of  
19 Osteopathic Examiners may also issue special licenses, including a  
20 Temporary License, a Resident Training License, a Telemedicine  
21 License or a Military Spouse License.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
