7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to sunset; amending 73 O.S. 2011,
9 Section 83.1, as amended by Section 667, Chapter 304,
10 O.S.L. 2012 (73 O.S. Supp. 2012, Section 83.1), which
11 relates to the Capitol-Medical Center Improvement and
12 Zoning Commission; re-creating the Commission; and
13 modifying termination date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2011, Section 83.1, as
16 amended by Section 667, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (73 O.S. Supp.
17 2012, Section 83.1), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 83.1 A. There is hereby re-created to continue until
19 July 1, ~~2013~~ 2019, in accordance with the Oklahoma Sunset Law,
20 Section 3901 et seq. of Title 74, a Capitol-Medical Center
21 Improvement and Zoning Commission to exercise the functions and
22 perform the duties hereinafter prescribed.

23 B. The Commission shall be composed of eleven (11) members as
24 follows:

1 1. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
2 Services or his or her designee, who shall be ex officio chair of
3 the Capitol-Medical Center Improvement and Zoning Commission;

4 2. The Director of the Transportation Commission or his or her
5 designee;

6 3. The President of the University of Oklahoma or his or her
7 designee;

8 4. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
9 Senate;

10 5. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
11 Representatives; and

12 6. The Chairman of the Planning Commission of Oklahoma City or
13 his or her designee. The remaining three members of the Commission
14 shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of
15 the State Senate, for three-year staggered terms with one term
16 expiring on January 31 of each year.

17 C. One of the three members shall be appointed upon the
18 recommendation of the Citizens' Advisory Committee. The Commission
19 is authorized to appoint and hire a Director, who shall serve as the
20 chief administrative officer of the Commission, and other necessary
21 personnel. The Attorney General of the State of Oklahoma shall be
22 the legal advisor to said Commission in the same capacity as he or
23 she is to other boards and commissions.

1 D. At least one of the members appointed by the President Pro
2 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
3 Representatives shall be a resident within the boundaries of the
4 Capitol-Medical Center Improvement and Zoning District as set forth
5 in Section 83 of this title.
