8 An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; prohibiting
9 certain acts relating to low-point beer; providing
10 punishment; providing for codification; and providing
11 an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.19A of Title 37, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. No state agency or political subdivision thereof, county or
18 political subdivision thereof, or municipalities or political
19 subdivisions thereof shall use public or private funds, employees or
20 resources to alter, obliterate, mark or modify low-point beer
21 packaging on the premises of a retail dealer.

22 B. No person shall alter, obliterate, mark or modify low-point
23 beer packaging on the premises of a retail dealer.

1 C. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section
2 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined
3 not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or imprisoned in a
4 county jail not exceeding one (1) year or shall be punished by both
5 such fine and imprisonment.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
