8 An Act relating to torts; providing immunity from
9 civil liability for certain actions during a natural
10 disaster or catastrophic event; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5.9 of Title 76, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any individual, business or school that renders emergency care,
17 aid, shelter or other assistance during a natural disaster or
18 catastrophic event shall not be liable for damages resulting from
19 the rendering of emergency care, aid, shelter or assistance unless
20 the damage was caused by the gross negligence or willful or wanton
21 misconduct of the individual or entity rendering the emergency care,
22 aid, shelter or assistance.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
