7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2011,  
9 Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and  
10 Milk Products Act; providing the act will not  
11 prohibit advertising of certain sales of raw milk;  
12 requiring raw milk sold in certain manner to be  
13 unpasteurized; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-414, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk  
18 Products Act shall not be construed to:

19 1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers  
20 at the farm where the milk is produced;

21 2. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sales of raw  
22 milk;

23 3. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sale of goat  
24 milk; and

1       ~~3.~~ 4. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using  
2 milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.

3       B. A provider of raw milk sold in outside road stands shall be  
4 unpasteurized raw milk. Raw milk could be hazardous to unborn  
5 children.

6       C. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk  
7 are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold  
8 does not exceed one hundred (100).

9       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
