7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to extramural athletic competition;
9 amending 70 O.S. 2011, Section 8-103.2, which relates
10 to rules governing eligibility for extramural
11 athletic competition for transfer students; updating
12 statutory references; authorizing the Oklahoma
13 Secondary School Activities Association to utilize an
14 administrative law judge for determining eligibility;
15 and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 8-103.2, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 8-103.2 A. Except as otherwise provided, a student who
20 enrolls, pursuant to the Education Open Transfer Act or pursuant to
21 Section ~~2~~ 8-113 of this ~~act~~ title, in a school district in which the
22 student is not a resident shall not be eligible to participate in
23 school-related extramural athletic competition governed by the
24 Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association for a period of one
(1) year from the first day of attendance at the receiving school

1 unless the transfer is from a school district which does not offer
2 the grade the student is entitled to pursue.

3 B. If the student is granted an emergency transfer pursuant to
4 Section 8-104 of this title, was granted a transfer for any reason
5 prior to January 1, 2000, or enrolls pursuant to the Education Open
6 Transfer Act and qualifies for a hardship waiver pursuant to the
7 rules of the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association,
8 ~~eligibility to participate in school-related extramural athletic~~
9 ~~competition shall be determined by~~ the Oklahoma Secondary School
10 Activities Association may utilize an administrative law judge to
11 conduct hearings regarding student eligibility to participate in
12 school-related extramural athletic competition.

13 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
