9 An Act relating to environment and natural resources;
10 creating the Federal Clean Water Act Grant Revolving
11 Fund; listing sources of the fund; authorizing the
12 Secretary of Energy and Environment to budget and
13 expend monies in the fund; directing that
14 expenditures from the fund be made under certain
15 conditions; creating the Environmental Programs
16 Revolving Fund; authorizing the Secretary of Energy
17 and Environment to budget and expend monies in the
18 fund; directing that expenditures from the fund be
19 made under certain conditions; providing for
20 codification; and providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-103 of Title 27A, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet
position having authority over the Department of Environmental
Quality to be designated the "Federal Clean Water Act Grant

1 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
2 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
3 by the Secretary from gifts, grants, private donations or federal
4 funding that are not designated for deposit to any other fund as
5 authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund
6 are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
7 Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from
8 said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
9 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the
10 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
11 payment.

12 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-104 of Title 27A, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
16 for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet
17 position having authority over the Department of Environmental
18 Quality to be designated the "Environmental Programs Revolving
19 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
20 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
21 Secretary from appropriations, fees, charges, penalties, and any
22 other sources that are not designated for deposit to any other fund
23 as authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said
24 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the

1 Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from
2 said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
3 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the
4 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
5 payment.

6 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
