10 An Act relating to the Sex Offenders Registration
11 Act; amending 57 O.S. 2011, Section 582, which
12 relates to registration requirements; making persons
convicted of certain crime subject to registration
requirements; and providing an effective date.

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 582, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 582. A. The provisions of the Sex Offenders
19 Registration Act shall apply to any person residing, working or
20 attending school within the State of Oklahoma who, after November 1,
21 1989, has been convicted, whether upon a verdict or plea of guilty
22 or upon a plea of nolo contendere, or received a suspended sentence
23 or any probationary term, or is currently serving a sentence or any
24 form of probation or parole for a crime or an attempt to commit a

1 crime provided for in Section 843.5 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
2 Statutes if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation
3 as those terms are defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title 10A of the
4 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 681, if the offense involved sexual
5 assault, 741, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
6 exploitation, Section 748, if the offense involved human trafficking
7 for commercial sex, Section 843.1, if the offense involved sexual
8 abuse or sexual exploitation, Section 852.1, if the offense involved
9 sexual abuse of a child, 865 et seq., 885, 886, 888, 891, if the
10 offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, 1021, 1021.2,
11 1021.3, 1024.2, 1040.12a, 1040.13, 1040.13a, 1087, 1088, 1111.1,
12 1114 or 1123 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

13 B. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall
14 apply to any person who after November 1, 1989, resides, works or
15 attends school within the State of Oklahoma and who has been
16 convicted or received a suspended sentence at any time in any court
17 of another state, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam,
18 American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and the United States
19 Virgin Islands, a federal court, an Indian tribal court, a military
20 court, or a court of a foreign country for a crime, attempted crime
21 or a conspiracy to commit a crime which, if committed or attempted
22 in this state, would be a crime, an attempt to commit a crime or a
23 conspiracy to commit a crime provided for in any of said laws listed
24 in subsection A of this section.

1 C. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall
2 apply to any person who resides, works or attends school within the
3 State of Oklahoma and who has received a deferred judgment at any
4 time in any court of another state, the District of Columbia, Puerto
5 Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and the
6 United States Virgin Islands, a federal court, an Indian tribal
7 court, a military court, or a court of a foreign country for a
8 crime, attempted crime or a conspiracy to commit a crime which, if
9 committed or attempted or conspired to be committed in this state,
10 would be a crime, an attempt to commit a crime or a conspiracy to
11 commit a crime provided for in Section 843.5 of Title 21 of the
12 Oklahoma Statutes if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
13 exploitation as those terms are defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title
14 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes, Section 681, if the offense involved
15 sexual assault, 741, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
16 exploitation, Section 748, if the offense involved human trafficking
17 for commercial sex, Section 843.1, if the offense involved sexual
18 abuse or sexual exploitation, Section 852.1, if the offense involved
19 sexual abuse of a child, 865 et seq., 885, 886, 888, 891, if the
20 offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, 1021, 1021.2,
21 1021.3, 1024.2, 1040.12a, 1040.13, 1040.13a, 1087, 1088, 1111.1,
22 1114 or 1123 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The provisions
23 of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall not apply to any such
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1 person while the person is incarcerated in a maximum or medium
2 correctional institution of the Department of Corrections.

3 D. On the effective date of this act, any person registered as
4 a sex offender pursuant to Section 741 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
5 Statutes shall be summarily removed from the Sex Offender Registry
6 by the Department of Corrections and all law enforcement agencies of
7 any political subdivision of this state, unless the offense involved
8 sexual abuse or sexual exploitation.

9 E. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall
10 not apply to any such person who has received a criminal history
11 records expungement for a conviction in another state for a crime or
12 attempted crime which, if committed or attempted in this state,
13 would be a crime or an attempt to commit a crime provided for in any
14 said laws listed in subsection A of this section.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.

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
