1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.195 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 74 beginning at the intersection of
5 West Waterloo Road and extending north to the intersection of State
6 Highway 74F shall be designated as the "Lance Corporal Jonathan
7 Stroud Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
8 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
9 the highway.

10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.196 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the municipal limits
14 of Perry and extending east to the municipal limits of Morrison
15 shall be designated as the "Captain Kyle King Memorial Highway".
16 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
17 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

18 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.197 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge over the Washita River on State Highway 53 northeast
22 of the municipal limits of Ardmore shall be designated as the "PFC
23 Philip F. Gaines Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation

1 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
2 placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.198 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over Lake Eufaula on State Highway 9A between the
7 municipal limits of Canadian and Longtown shall be designated as the
8 "First Lieutenant S.W. "Dub" George Memorial Bridge". The
9 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
10 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

11 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.199 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of State Highway 7 beginning at the intersection of
15 State Highway 65 in Comanche County and extending eastward to the
16 intersection of U.S. Highway 81 in Stephens County shall be
17 designated as the "Army Ranger Staff Sgt. Vinson Bryon "Trinity"
18 Adkinson, III Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
19 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
20 placed on the highway.

21 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.200 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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1 The bridge where U.S. Highway 69 crosses the Arkansas River at
2 the Wagoner and Muskogee county line shall be designated as the
3 "Specialist Joshua M. "Bubba" Seals Memorial Bridge". Pursuant to
4 the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department
5 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
6 placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

7 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.201 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The section of State Highway 82 beginning at the southern
11 municipal limit of Vian and extending north to the municipal limit
12 of Vian shall be designated as the "Captain Frederick F. Henry Medal
13 of Honor Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
14 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
15 the highway.

16 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1600, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1600. A. The cost associated with signage related to
19 the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway system shall
20 be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign. The
21 provisions of this section shall not apply to the naming of highways
22 and bridges on the state highway system designed to honor members of
23 the United States Armed Forces who were killed ~~in action~~ while
24 participating in contingency operations.

1 B. As used in this section, the term "contingency operation"
2 means a military operation that:

3 1. Is designated by the Secretary of Defense as an operation in
4 which members of the armed forces are or may become involved in
5 military actions, operations or hostilities against an enemy of the
6 United States or against an opposing military force; or

7 2. Results in the call or order to, or retention on, active
8 duty of members of the uniformed services under Section 688,
9 12301(a), 12302, 12304, 12304a, 12305 or 12406 of Title 10 U.S.C.,
10 Chapter 15 of Title 10 U.S.C., Section 712 of Title 14 U.S.C., or
11 any other provision of law during a war or during a national
12 emergency declared by the President or Congress.

13 C. The Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules
14 establishing a procedure to assess and collect the cost of the
15 signs. The assessment of cost shall include the cost of the initial
16 erection of the sign as well as the potential replacement or
17 reconstruction of the sign. The cost of these signs shall be based
18 on an average of the cost of signs erected during the preceding
19 fiscal year, as reported by the Department of Transportation.

20 SECTION 10. REPEALER Section 12, Chapter 270, O.S.L.
21 2013 (69 O.S. Supp. 2013, Section 1698.171), is hereby repealed.

22 SECTION 11. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.

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
