10 An Act relating to juvenile detention; directing
11 Office of Management and Enterprise Services to
12 initiate certain requests for proposals; authorizing
13 Office to enter into a lease-purchase agreement and
14 certain contracts; directing Office to promulgate
15 rules and procedures; directing collaboration between
16 Office of Management and Enterprise Services and
17 applicable state agencies; providing for
18 codification; and providing an effective date.

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-616 of Title 10A, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
initiate a separate request for proposals for the construction of a
suitable facility for the purpose of actively rehabilitating
juveniles in a staff-secure, academic-model juvenile program that
uses evidence-based cognitive behavioral therapy, research-supported

1 interventions, individualized treatment plans and an effective
2 behavioral management system. The Office is authorized to enter
3 into a lease-purchase agreement for the construction or acquisition
4 of such facility, pursuant to the provisions of law.

5 B. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
6 initiate a separate request for proposals for the razing of property
7 needed to construct the facility specified in subsection A of this
8 section. The Office is authorized to enter into a contract for the
9 razing of property, pursuant to the provisions of law.

10 C. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
11 initiate a separate request for proposals for the management and
12 operation of the facility specified in subsection A of this section.
13 The Office is authorized to enter into a contract for the management
14 and operation of such facility, pursuant to the provisions of law.

15 D. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services is
16 authorized to promulgate rules and establish procedures necessary to
17 implement the provisions of this act.

18 E. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall work
19 in conjunction with applicable state agencies to implement the
20 provisions of this act.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.

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
