10 An Act relating to oil and gas; requiring the
11 Corporation Commission to promulgate rules governing
12 reporting requirements for certain landfill disposal
13 of drilling waste materials; stating time period;
14 stating requirements for reporting and making
15 information available to the public; providing for
16 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
19 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

20 No later than sixty (60) days following the effective date of
21 this act, the Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules as
22 necessary to implement the following:

23 Oil and gas operators disposing of any oil field waste
24 materials, including drilling fluids and solids, by method of
disposal in any commercial solid waste disposal site regulated by

1 the Department of Environmental Quality, shall be required to
2 maintain a record, report and/or manifest of such material. The
3 manifest shall include, but not limited to, generator of the waste,
4 source of the waste, volume of the waste, and the disposal site.

5 The Commission shall require information on drilling waste
6 materials disposed of in commercial solid waste disposal sites to be
7 included in such record, report and/or manifest in the same manner
8 as such information is recorded and maintained for other disposal
9 methods authorized by the Commission. Such reporting requirements
10 shall not be more or less stringent than is required for any other
11 disposal method authorized by the Commission. In addition, the
12 Commission shall make such information available to the public in
13 the same manner as similar information is made available to the
14 public.

15 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
