14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3242.3 of Title 70, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall adopt
19 a policy which allows a student to enroll in an institution within
20 The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education and be eligible for
21 resident tuition if the student:

22 1. Satisfies admission standards as determined by the Oklahoma
23 State Regents for Higher Education for the appropriate type of
24 institution and has secured admission to and enrolled in an

1 institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education;
2 and

3 2. Presents to the institution valid documentation of receipt
4 of an Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps, Army Reserve
5 Officers' Training Corps or Navy/Marines Reserve Officers' Training
6 Corps full scholarship.

7 B. Students who are only participants in or who have received
8 only partial scholarships from the Air Force Reserve Officers'
9 Training Corps, Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps or the
10 Navy/Marines Reserve Officers' Training Corps shall not be eligible
11 for resident tuition as provided for in subsection A.

12 C. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall
13 promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
