9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to the Office of Juvenile Affairs;
11 permitting Board of Juvenile Affairs to administer
12 charter school; providing promulgation of
13 administrative rules; directing Office of Juvenile
14 Affairs to administer, operate, and staff charter
15 school; providing certain staff be in unclassified
16 service and be eligible for the Teachers' Retirement
17 System of Oklahoma; providing for codification; and
18 declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-616 of Title 10A, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 A. For the purposes of establishing and operating a charter
24 school, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-130 et seq. of Title
70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Board of Juvenile Affairs may serve
as the governing body of the charter school and may take any action
necessary to serve in such capacity and in accordance with rules of

1 the State Board of Education. The Board of Juvenile Affairs may
2 promulgate rules as necessary for the establishment and operation of
3 such charter school and shall establish policies and provide
4 oversight for any such charter school.

5 B. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs
6 shall provide for the administration and operation of any charter
7 school established and operated by the Office of Juvenile Affairs.

8 C. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs may
9 employ instructional and administrative personnel necessary for the
10 operation of a charter school and may contract with such personnel
11 for the terms and conditions of their employment or for the services
12 provided. Instructional and administrative personnel employed by
13 the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall be in the unclassified service.
14 Such personnel shall be eligible for membership or participation in
15 the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma.

16 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
