14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6850.1 of Title 36, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Any health benefit plan that provides prescription drug coverage
19 or contracts with a third-party for prescription drug services,
20 shall electronically notify enrollees presently taking a
21 prescription drug by email, or in writing upon request of the
22 enrollee, at least sixty (60) days prior to any deletions, other
23 than generic substitutions, in the health benefit plan's
24 prescription drug formulary.

1 As used in this section, "health benefit plan" means any plan or
2 arrangement as defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of Title 36
3 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
