10 An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring certain
11 step to be included in online motor vehicle license
12 agent systems; providing motor license agents receive
13 certain fees; providing for codification; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1132B of Title 47, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. If any service or transaction which a motor license agent is
20 authorized by law to provide is administered through any state
21 agency by means of an electronic transaction or online system, such
22 agency shall include a step where the individual must select between
23 any motor license agent in the state and the agency for processing
24 the service or transaction. This section shall not apply to

1 registrations processed pursuant to Section 1120 of Title 47 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes.

3 B. Motor license agents selected as provided in subsection A of
4 this section shall receive all fees provided by statute for the
5 service or transaction processed by the motor license agent through
6 any electronic transaction or online system administered by a state
7 agency.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
