9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to environment and natural resources;
11 creating the Environmental Remediation Revolving
12 Fund; listing sources of the fund; authorizing the
13 Secretary of Energy and Environment to budget and
14 expend monies in the fund; directing expenditures
15 from the fund be made under certain conditions;
16 creating the Environmental Programs Revolving Fund;
17 authorizing the Secretary of Energy and Environment
18 to budget and expend monies in the fund; directing
19 expenditures from the fund be made under certain
20 conditions; providing for codification; providing an
21 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-103 of Title 27A, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet
position having authority over the Department of Environmental

1 Quality to be designated the "Environmental Remediation Revolving
2 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
3 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
4 Secretary from Natural Resource Damage Assessments on behalf of the
5 State, pursuant to paragraph 4 of subsection A of Section 1-2-101 of
6 Title 27A, that are not designated for deposit to any other fund as
7 authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund
8 are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
9 Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from
10 the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
11 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the
12 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
13 payment.

14 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-104 of Title 27A, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
18 for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet
19 position having authority over the Department of Environmental
20 Quality to be designated the "Environmental Programs Revolving
21 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
22 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
23 Secretary from appropriations, fees, charges, penalties, and any
24 other sources that are not designated for deposit to any other fund

1 as authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund
2 are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
3 Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from
4 the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
5 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the
6 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
7 payment.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

9 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
