7 An Act relating to the Task Force on Management of
8 Federal Funds; creating Task Force; providing for
9 membership; providing for applicability of Oklahoma
10 Open Meeting Act and Oklahoma Open Records Act;
11 prescribing procedures for meeting notices; requiring
12 organizational meeting; providing for selection of
13 cochairs; prescribing quorum requirement; defining
14 scope of study by Task Force; requiring final report;
15 providing for termination of Task Force; providing
16 for codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6001 of Title 62, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. There is hereby created the "Task Force on Management of
22 Federal Funds".

23 B. The Task Force shall consist of eleven (11) members to be
24 appointed or otherwise serve as follows:

1. Three members to be appointed by the Governor;

1 2. Three members to be appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma
2 House of Representatives;

3 3. Three members to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore
4 of the Oklahoma State Senate;

5 4. One member who shall be the Director of the Office of
6 Management and Enterprise Services or a designee of the Director;
7 and

8 5. One member who shall be the Director of the Oklahoma Tax
9 Commission or the designee of the Director.

10 C. The Task Force shall be subject to the provisions of the
11 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act and the Oklahoma Open Records Act. The
12 Task Force shall be authorized to post notice of its meetings at
13 least seven (7) days in advance of the meeting date using a written
14 posting, a website-based posting or both such methods. Such notice
15 shall be deemed to be in compliance with the requirements of the
16 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act with respect to the meeting notice.

17 D. The Task Force shall conduct an organizational meeting not
18 later than October 1, 2013. The Task Force shall select from among
19 its membership a chair and cochair. The Task Force shall be
20 authorized to meet as often as required in order to perform the
21 duties imposed upon it.

22 E. A quorum of the members of the Task Force physically present
23 at a meeting shall be required to take any affirmative action
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1 including the adoption of the final report required by subsection G
2 of this section.

3 F. The Task Force shall study the methods by which state
4 government entities receive federal funds. The study shall include,
5 but shall not be limited to:

6 1. An evaluation and report upon any conditions imposed
7 pursuant to federal statute, federal administrative rules, federal
8 executive order or other source of federal law with respect to the
9 receipt and expenditure of the funds received by any state
10 government entity;

11 2. An analysis of any action required to be taken by the state
12 government entity as a condition for the receipt or continued
13 receipt of federal funds;

14 3. An analysis of any action prohibited to be taken by the
15 state government entity as a condition for the receipt or continued
16 receipt of federal funds;

17 4. An analysis of any action required to be taken by any
18 individual or lawfully recognized business entity or other entity as
19 a condition for the benefits purported to be conferred on the
20 individual or other legal entity as a result of the use of the
21 federal funds;

22 5. An analysis of any action prohibited to be taken by any
23 individual or lawfully recognized business entity or other entity as
24 a condition for the benefits purported to be conferred on the

1 individual or other legal entity as a result of the use of the
2 federal funds; and

3 6. An analysis of the relationship between the citizens of the
4 State of Oklahoma, both natural persons and business entities, with
5 regard to taxes imposed at the state level and taxes imposed by the
6 federal government.

7 G. The Task Force shall prepare a final report which shall be
8 submitted to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
9 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
10 Senate not later than December 31, 2013. The Task Force shall cease
11 to have any authority to take official action after December 31,
12 2013.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
