8 An Act relating to property; defining term;
9 prohibiting adoption of United Nations Agenda
10 21/Sustainable Development policies that restrict
11 private property rights without due process;
12 prohibiting state and political subdivisions from
13 entering into certain agreements and expending and
14 receiving funds to implement United Nations Agenda
15 21/Sustainable Development; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 100 of Title 60, unless there is
18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. As used in this section, "political subdivisions" means any
20 state, county, city, town, municipality, district, public local
21 entity, public-private partnership or any other public entity of the
22 state, a county, city, town or municipality.

23 B. The state or any political subdivision of the state shall
24 not adopt or implement policy recommendations that deliberately or

1 | inadvertently infringe upon or restrict private property rights
2 | without due process, as may be required by policy recommendations
3 | originating in, or traceable to United Nations Agenda 21/Sustainable
4 | Development and any of its subsequent modifications, a resolution
5 | adopted by the United Nations in 1992 at its Conference on
6 | Environment and Development held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil and
7 | commonly known as the Earth Summit and reconfirmed in its Rio+20
8 | Conference held in Rio de Janeiro in June 2012, or any other
9 | international law or ancillary plan of action that contravenes the
10 | Constitution of the United States or the Oklahoma Constitution.

11 | C. Since the United Nations has accredited or enlisted numerous
12 | nongovernmental and intergovernmental organizations to assist in the
13 | implementation of its policies relative to United Nations Agenda
14 | 21/Sustainable Development around the world, the state and all
15 | political subdivisions of the state shall not enter into any
16 | agreement, expend any sum of money, receive funds contracting
17 | services or give financial aid to or from any nongovernmental or
18 | intergovernmental organizations accredited or enlisted by the United
19 | Nations.

20 | SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
