7 An Act relating to sunset; amending 74 O.S. 2011,
8 Section 18p-2, which relates to the Domestic Violence
9 and Sexual Assault Advisory Council; removing Council
10 from Oklahoma Sunset Law; re-creating Council within
11 the Office of the Attorney General; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 18p-2, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 18p-2. A. There is hereby re-created, ~~to continue~~
17 ~~until July 1, 2013, in accordance with provisions of the Oklahoma~~
18 ~~Sunset Law,~~ the Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Advisory
19 Council within the Office of the Attorney General. The Council
20 shall be a nine-member committee appointed by the Attorney General.

21 B. Four of the members shall be selected from a list of eight
22 nominees provided by the Oklahoma Coalition on Domestic Violence and
23 Sexual Assault and five of the members shall be selected by the
24 Attorney General from the State of Oklahoma at large; provided, that
of the members selected by the Attorney General from the state at

1 large, one member shall be a representative of any domestic violence
2 programs funded through or by the Attorney General, and one member
3 shall be a citizen of this state with expertise in the area of
4 sexual assault services.

5 C. The Council shall select a chair annually. Appointment to
6 the Council shall be for two (2) years. The Attorney General shall
7 appoint persons to fill unexpired terms when necessary.

8 D. The duties of the Council shall be to review rules and
9 overall policies relating to the operation and funding of domestic
10 violence and sexual assault programs in this state and make
11 recommendations to the Attorney General regarding its findings.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
