10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
12 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

13 It is the intent of the Legislature to support the control of
14 invasive plants and animal species. It is the specific intent of
15 the Legislature to support increased agricultural burning to control
16 noxious weeds and eastern red cedar trees and to encourage county,
17 state and federal government control of eastern red cedar trees on
18 right-of-ways.

19 It is also the specific intent of the Legislature to diligently
20 address the problem of feral hog eradication by increasing funding
21 to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. The
22 Legislature encourages the Oklahoma Department of Corrections to
23 pursue the processing of feral hogs for use by state correctional

1 facilities and any excess to be made available to any available
2 markets, including food banks.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
