8 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
9 requiring and authorizing certain expenditures;
10 requiring and authorizing certain transfers of funds;
11 authorizing Patrol Academy; reappropriating certain
12 funds; providing an effective date; and declaring an
13 emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of
16 Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the
17 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Twenty-six Thousand
18 Dollars (\$26,000.00) shall be expended for the services of a Capitol
19 Patrol Officer to the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court pursuant
20 to a contract between the Department of Public Safety and the
21 Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court.

22 SECTION 2. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of
23 Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the
24 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Sixty-five Thousand

1 Dollars (\$65,000.00) shall be expended for the annual lease payment
2 of the Clinton/Sherman Industrial Complex.

3 SECTION 3. The Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized
4 to expend Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from the Department
5 of Public Safety Patrol Vehicle Revolving Fund for the fiscal year
6 ending June 30, 2014, for the purchase of patrol vehicles and
7 aircraft and equipping those vehicles and aircraft, as well as other
8 operational expenses of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol.

9 SECTION 4. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of
10 Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the
11 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Five Million Dollars
12 (\$5,000,000.00) shall be transferred to the Department of Public
13 Safety Patrol Academy Revolving Fund created by Section 2-146 of
14 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

15 SECTION 5. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of
16 Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the
17 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Three Hundred Eight
18 Thousand Two Hundred Forty-six Dollars (\$308,246.00) shall be
19 transferred to the Oklahoma Climatological Survey, under the
20 direction and supervision of the Board of Regents of the University
21 of Oklahoma, for the use of the Survey to perform its duties as
22 prescribed by law.

23 SECTION 6. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of
24 Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the

1 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Nine Hundred thirty-
2 five Thousand Eight Hundred One Dollars (\$935,801.00) shall be
3 transferred to the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security. Of the
4 funds transferred herein, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
5 (\$100,000.00) is authorized for transfer to the Oklahoma Homeland
6 Security Revolving Fund created by Section 51.2 of Title 74 of the
7 Oklahoma Statutes.

8 SECTION 7. The Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal year
9 ending June 30, 2014, is authorized to have one (1) Patrol Academy
10 consisting of no fewer than thirty (30) cadets.

11 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION The amount of One Million One
12 Hundred Ninety-five Thousand One Hundred Forty-five Dollars
13 (\$1,195,145.00) of the original appropriation of Ninety-eight
14 Million Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-one
15 Dollars (\$98,370,391.00) appropriated to the Department of Public
16 Safety by Section 119, Chapter 317, O.S.L. 2007, from monies not
17 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
18 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, to perform the
19 duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law, is
20 hereby reappropriated for the purpose of construction of a new Troop
21 K Headquarters. If, on the date this act is approved, any of the
22 amount originally appropriated, as adjusted by expenditures,
23 encumbrances and transfers, results in an unencumbered balance less
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1 than the reappropriated amount, that reappropriated amount is
2 reduced to the unencumbered amount.

3 SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

4 SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
