7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;
8 amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 165, which relates to
9 travel allowance; and modifying travel allowance for
10 certain county officers.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 165, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 165. A. In lieu of reimbursement for traveling
16 expenses within their county each county commissioner and sheriff
17 may receive a monthly travel allowance of ~~Six Hundred Dollars~~
18 ~~(\$600.00)~~ not more than Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$950.00). In
19 lieu of the reimbursement for traveling expenses authorized by law
20 for each county officer, each county assessor may receive a monthly
21 travel allowance of ~~Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)~~ not more than
22 Seven Hundred Ninety-one Dollars and fifty cents (\$791.50), and each
23 county clerk, court clerk and county treasurer may receive a monthly
24 travel allowance of ~~Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00)~~ not more than Six

1 Hundred Thirty-three Dollars and twenty cents (\$633.20). Each such
2 county officer may be subject to the penalty provided by Section 166
3 of this title for failure to attend the meetings specified in that
4 section.

5 B. All newly elected county officials shall be reimbursed by
6 their respective counties for any approved training provided before
7 such official takes office. Such training expenses shall be
8 reimbursed in January when such official takes office.

9 C. The provisions of this section and Sections 163 and 164 of
10 this title shall not prevent the emergency use of a county-owned
11 vehicle or county-owned equipment by a county officer when such
12 county officer is acting on behalf of the county or when such use is
13 related to county business. As used in this subsection, "emergency"
14 means an unforeseen combination of circumstances or the resulting
15 state that calls for immediate action.
